Like for instance, a crane operator needs to take an in-depth training course and must pass different certification exams in order to become a crane operator, while truck drivers could only need some on the job training to go along with their CDL. The in-depth training that follows particular equipment is essential as a lot of the work occurs in hazardous scenarios and hazardous scenes so the operator must be able to make sure of a safe working environment all the time. The safety training is very important along with the communications training that helps the group on the ground be able to communicate with the operator at all times.

Heavy equipment machinery normally work in extreme environments and are put under great strain on a regular basis. Thus, there are many heavy equipment jobs available in repair and maintenance. Operators of heavy equipment are really trained workers who are able to troubleshoot, repair and diagnose heavy machines on site or in a workshop. Normally, the drivers operate along with chaperone vehicles which are driven by trained drivers. These chaperone vehicles normally escort the delivery truck to its destination.
